

OVERVIEW

2025 marks the 44th Annual Prairie Dog Seminar. First held in 1981, it has evolved into one of the premier CLE courses in Texas and consistently draws top-speakers from across the State as well as prominent local attorneys. Proceeds are donated to the Brendan Murray Scholarship at Texas Tech School of Law. Brendan is the late son of the late Brian E Murray, a longtime TCDLA member. Brendan died unexpectedly while in law school, and has been honored ever since his death with a substantial yearly donation to the School of Law in his memory. A very important component of Prairie Dog is Prairie Pup, a nuts and bolts seminar for young attorneys, taught by local attorneys providing both mentorship and education on "what we do".
